# Infrastructure

- This will be broken down into 3 area's buildings, streets and equipment in both current conditions and preventive maintenance plan.
- Village hall is in good overall condition, in need of technological upgrade and general over all up keep. No major issues on the horizon.
- Waste Water treatment plan is in final stages of a 14 million dollar renovation, only upgrade will be in the process.
- Town Barns, Has new roof and heating units plus new storage and wood shop. In very good condition. No future major plans.



## **Infrastructure cont.**

- New automotive shop constructed in 2024 for police and DPW vehicle maintenance. Should be good for years.
- Streets above ground are in a good place with all streets having had work done, either regrinds or total renovations. There are no plans for future total renovation. Village will have a plan to oil and stone 20% of the streets each year to keep from major reconstruction.
- Over a million dollars in sidewalk work done in the last 10 years, continue in a less aggressive manner.
- Water lines are the responsibility of Monroe County Water Authority.
- Sanitary and storm sewers need constant upkeep and care.

- **Equipment:** Overall is in great shape with a used police car program that has put us in a enjoyable position to buy used cars and use the rest of there life before auctioning them off
