**NEW BUSINESS:**

**RESOLUTION TO DECLARE POLICE DEPT EQUIPMENT SURPLUS FOR PURPOSE OF DISPOSAL AND TO TRANSFER FUNDS**

**MOTION BY** Trustee Yacuzzo

**WHEREAS,** The LeRoy Police Department has declared the equipment listed below surplus; and

**WHEREAS,** the Village of LeRoy requires a surplus declaration of property to be made prior to disposal or sale of equipment; and

**WHEREAS,** the Police Department desires to use the proceeds from selling the equipment listed below in order to offset the purchase of future equipment needs by placing the proceeds into A895 Police Equipment Reserve;

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,** the LeRoy Village Board hereby authorizes the following declared as surplus for the purpose of disposal:

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED,** that the LeRoy Village Board of Trustees does hereby authorize the transfer of the proceeds from the sale of said equipment to A895 Police Equipment Reserve.

### **RESOLUTION PROCLAIMING “JOHN BOLTON DAY”**

MOTION BY Trustee Bonacquisti

WHEREAS, John Bolton was a resident of LeRoy, New York, and a graduating member of the LeRoy High School Class of 1980, and

WHEREAS, John’s hometown and the John Bolton Day Committee greatly admire his lifetime of accomplishments on and off-Broadway, with national tours, and on television, and

WHEREAS, John has selflessly given his time, energy, and talent to generations of LeRoy theater students, and

WHEREAS, the Village Board is appreciative of the dedication and efforts by John to the LeRoy community, and

WHEREAS, the Village Board would like to recognize John’s achievements to the community,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Village of LeRoy Board of Trustees declares May 18, 2025, be known as “JOHN BOLTON DAY”

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board of Trustees authorizes the Mayor of the Village to sign said proclamation so stating and the seal of the Village be affixed thereto.

## **OFFICIAL CONSIDERATIONS:**

Trustee Bonacquisti: He still hasn’t received the Vacant Home Registry list from Code Enforcement yet and he asked two weeks ago. The Mayor mentioned that Rotary was buying benches for the splash park and Trustee Bonacquisti thought that was a great idea.

Trustee Yacuzzo: He received a resident request that the Village restripe the basketball courts on Mill St. and asked the Clerk to pass it on to Sup. Lathan.

Trustee Kettle: He’s concerned about the many watermain breaks and the condition of the roads as a result and felt they should table the Mill St. Park work until the streets were done. Also, with Henry’s moving down the street to the old Java’s building with the potential for more seating, and with other buildings and businesses in the area, there will be a greater need for parking and he’s not sure that Main St. and the Mill St. lot can handle it. They will have to field issues as they go forward.

## **AUTHORIZATION TO PAY BILLS:**

Trustee Bonacquisti made a motion to pay bills, reluctantly, retroactive to 3/18/25. It was seconded by Trustee Yacuzzo and passed unanimously. Payment is as follows:
